



SAFETY POLICY

As İGA Airport Operation Inc.,

safety at our airport is our most important activity. While developing Istanbul Airport into one of the world's most important hubs, it is our common goal to give service in compliance with the standards which we are bound to and reach a productive level of organizational culture. To that end, the fundamentals and principles we adopt in our activities include well-balanced distribution of resources, developing strategies and processes, create a solid and sustainable positive safety culture within the company through the implementation, continuous review and improvement of an efficient Safety Management System (SMS), and notably:

- Monitoring all processes with a corporate structure that complies with applicable legislation in order to ensure positive development and continuity of SMS within our organizational structure,
- In line with our primary objective of “Zero Accident, Zero Serious Incident”, conducting hazard risk analyses to mitigate any possible hazards to life and property and reducing the risks to an acceptable level,
- Identifying any factors that affect safety and performing continuous review on these factors to bring them under control,
- Adopting a proactive approach to prevent accidents, serious incidents or incidents before they happen, rather than a reactive approach after an undesired event has occurred,
- Identify and assess hazards that jeopardize safety, reducing them to the minimum level possible or to an acceptable level of safety (ALoS), and monitoring the process through safety risk management,
- Satisfying the manpower, software, hardware, funding and all sorts of other requirements needed for SMS,
- Based on our mindset that safety is the responsibility of all personnel in an environment of fair and equitable culture, encouraging our personnel to make compulsory and/or voluntary reporting in order to develop a positive safety culture, without having to face any adversities like retaliation or accusation for any hazards they will report, and rewarding the personnel when necessary,
- Developing and implementing effective communication strategies so that İGA personnel can follow the safety-related developments, and
- Share the data obtained from SMS at meetings, briefings and trainings.
